

These instructions stop webpages moving around on screens while trying to do an activity on the page.

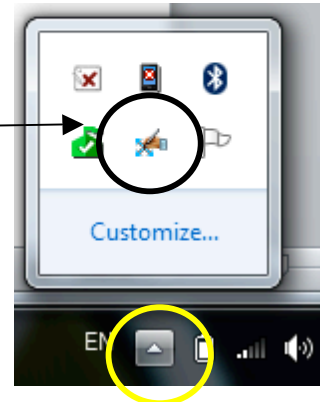

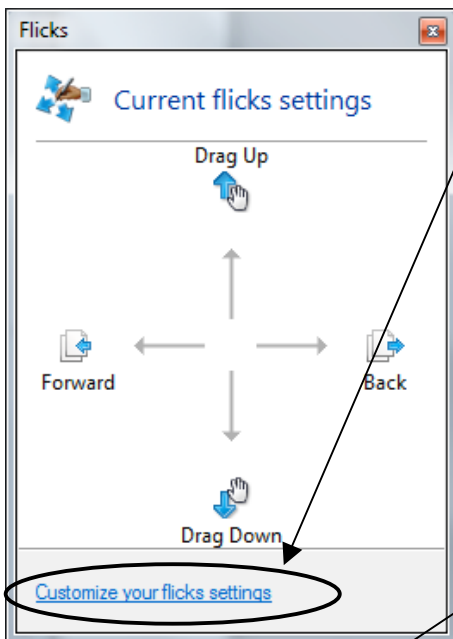
Your computer needs to be connected to the screen to do this.

Click on the Flicks icon in the notification area (bottom right of screen). You may have to click on the up arrow head to see it (Windows 7).

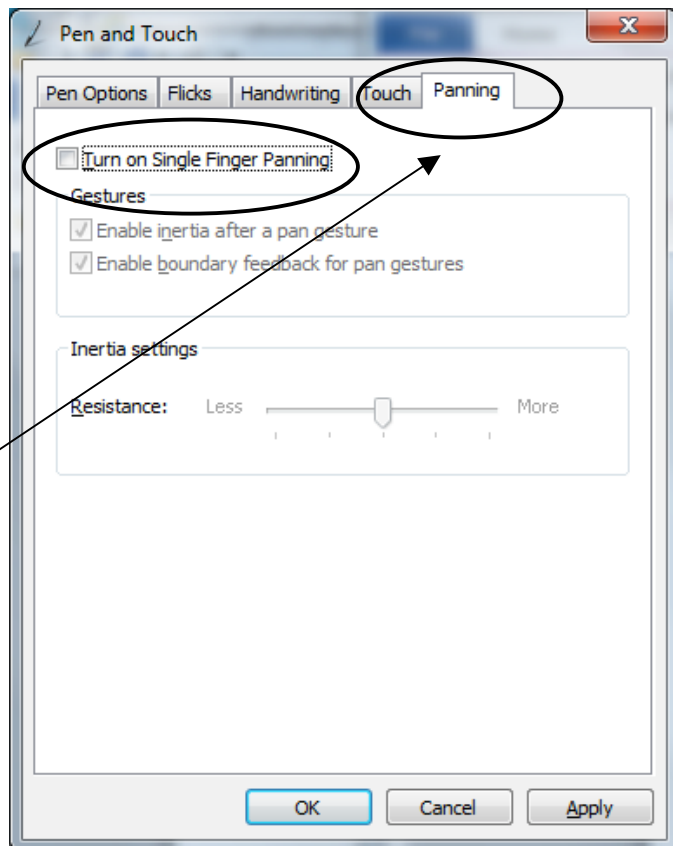
If you can't see this icon you can access it from the Control Panel of your computer under 'Pen and Touch'



You will see something like this:



Click on 'Customize your flicks settings' at the bottom.



Click on the 'Panning' tab and untick the box beside 'Turn on Single Finger Panning'. Click on OK.

You can now use activities without the page moving. To move pages up and down you use the normal scroll bar on the right side of a page.
