Learning Objectives: Pupils should be taught the human cost of flooding and in what ways flooding can be controlled.

Suggested activities:

Introduction: Looking at photographs of flooding identify how people living in areas prone to flooding are affected by floods.

Main: How are people warned about flooding? (see BBC Weather warning system at http://www.bbc.co.uk/weather/features/flooding.shtml)

Examine the National flood warning system. How much warning are people likely to receive? What can people do to minimise the flood risk? Based on this information children could design a leaflet to help householders prepare for flooding events.
